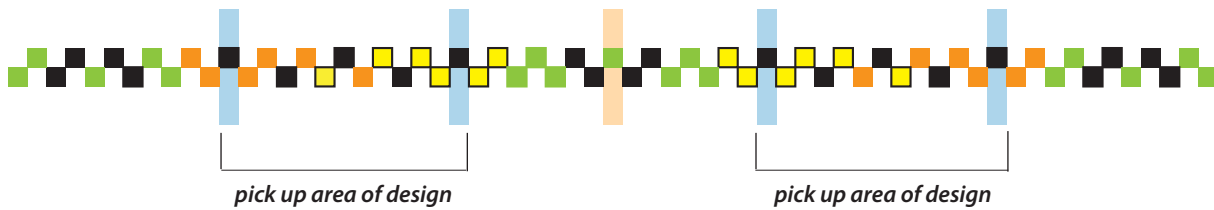

Warping Diagram

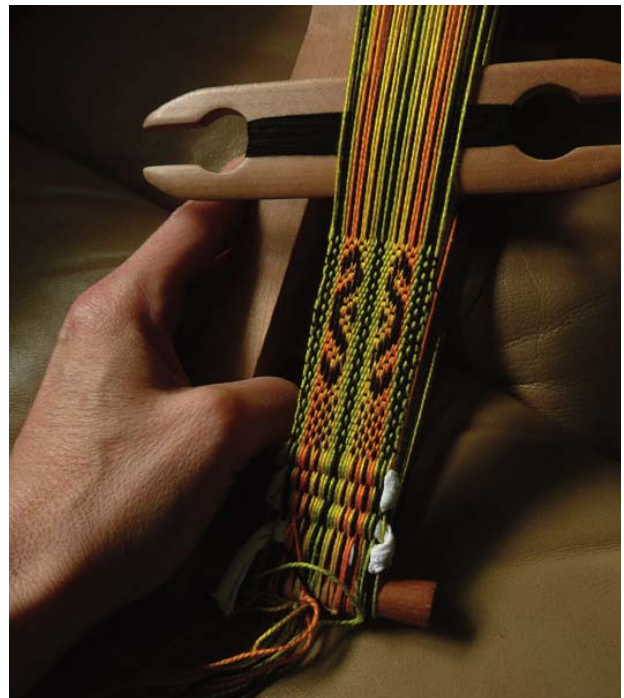


Setting Up the Loom

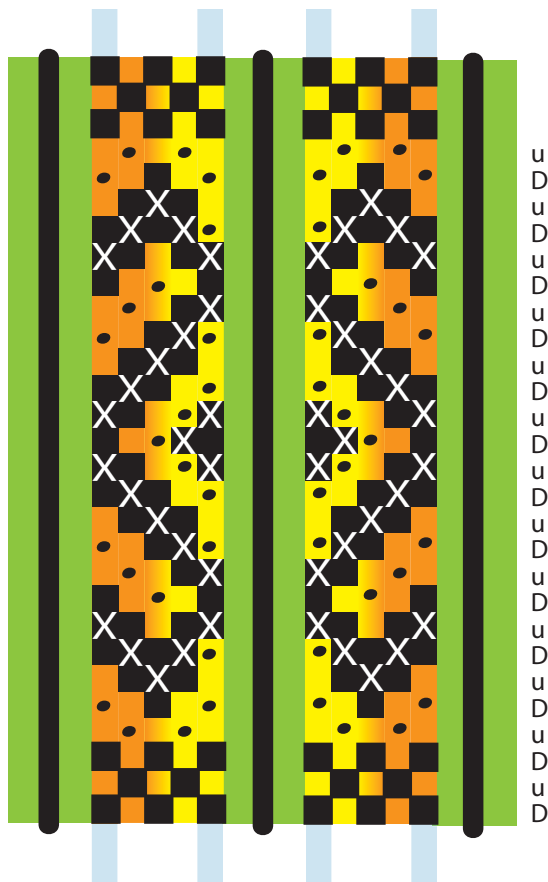
You will need 31 string heddles. Use differently-colored string heddles for the 5 warps indicated shown in teal (defines pick up area) & orange (defines center warp). This helps you track your pattern easily when treading.

There are 63 total warps: 22 black, 17 green, 12 orange, and 12 yellow.

There are 5 pattern warps (black) for the pickup design on the left and right sides of the band.



Treading Diagram



Treading Instructions for pattern pick-up
Only the border pick-up designs are shown in detail at left.

This is a continuously alternating pattern, starting from the bottom.

The key to the treading:

“u” = for this row, the warps are lifted UP
“D” = for this row, the warps are pressed DOWN.

The key to the pick-up:

“●” = the pattern thread which appears here needs to be pushed DOWN
“X” = the pattern thread needs to be lifted UP.
